(Travel north on M.L. King Ave, turn right on Pasadena Ave, and then turn right on Essex St)

**Pick Up:** You can get your purchases as a drive-through with kits and compost being placed in your car or you may park and visit the various booths that we have set up for the day.

**Bonus Table:** This table is for those interested purchasing additional plants and seeds! Eggplant, okra, and collard plants, and more(!) will be available at this table. Seeds will include a variety.
